

The AAPL 2017 Annual Meeting will focus on correctional psychiatry, with a dedicated "correctional track" of 8 presentations (2 in each time slot) on Saturday, October 28 and 9 other sessions on correctional topics throughout the meeting, including:

- New AAPL Resource Document on Prescribing in Correctional Facilities
 - Assessment of Malingering
- Community Alternatives to Incarceration for Persons with Mental Illness
 - Management of Gender Dysphoria in Corrections

AAPL offers two meeting rates for first time non-member correctional psychiatrists: a **\$95 weekend** rate (Saturday-Sunday only), and **\$350 for the entire meeting** (Thursday-Sunday). Qualified nonmember psychiatrists who register for the entire meeting may apply the fee toward the cost of AAPL membership. A total of **12.5 Category 1 CME credits for correctional psychiatry presentations** are offered Saturday and Sunday and a total of **31.75 Category 1 CME credits are offered overall**.
